Investigation of Metformin in Pre-Diabetes on Atherosclerotic Cardiovascular OuTcomes

88 million Americans have prediabetes. It is a mild elevation of blood sugar that can lead to diabetes. Pre-diabetes increases the risk of heart attack and stroke.

<u>Metformin</u> is a common drug approved by the Food and Drug Administration for diabetes. It is not approved for pre-diabetes.

The <u>VA-IMPACT</u> study will determine if metformin reduces the risk of heart attack, stroke, and related problems in patients with pre-diabetes.

You may be eligible to take part in this research study if:

- 1. Results from a recent blood test show mildly elevated sugar or hemoglobin A1c levels -and-
- 2. You have had previous signs of blood vessel problems in the circulation to your heart, brain, or legs

<u>Compensation</u>: You will be compensated a minimum of \$20 for the Randomization Visit and when study-related lab tests are done. The compensation amount may increase over time depending on local factors.
